- 4. Providing input and monitor the Bowls ACT website and/or other social media outlets in relation to officiating matters.
- 5. Advising the Executive Officer on details of accreditation on candidates who have completed relevant requirements.
- 6. Promoting an understanding of the Bowls Australia officials accreditation and reaccreditation system.

- Be a positive and professional role model for our sport.
- A current Working with Vulnerable People clearance.

- BA Presenter and Assessor qualifications

- A willingness to keep abreast of new and developing practices.
- An understanding of applicable BACT & BA Policies and Procedures.
