Specific Responsibilities

As a member of the Bowls ACT CC assist in:

1. Overseeing the provision of training for Bowls Australia (BA) accredited coaching courses.
2. Developing and conducting other appropriate coaching courses for affiliated Bowls ACT clubs.
3. Developing relevant training programs, such as bowlers' clinics, to improve the playing standards of bowls in the ACT.
4. Providing leadership, support and guidance to other coaches to facilitate their growth, development and success.
5. Providing input and monitor the Bowls ACT website and/or other social media outlets in relation to coaching matters.
6. Advising the Executive Officer on details of accreditation on candidates who have completed relevant requirements.
7. Promoting an understanding of the Bowls Australia coach accreditation and re-accreditation system.

Position Criteria

- Club Coach or higher coaching accreditation.
- Strong interpersonal skills including communication and leadership skills and the ability to motivate others.

- Be a positive and professional role model for our sport.
- A current Working with Vulnerable People clearance.

Desired

- BA Presenter and Assessor qualifications
- Previous experience in conducting training programs
- Completed BA Selection and Competition Module
- A willingness to keep abreast of new and developing coaching practices.
- An understanding of applicable ASADA requirements.
