



2021 sees the introduction of Goulburn Railway Women's Bowling Club into the Bowls ACT competition with fantastic numbers producing two teams in the combined Grade 1/2. We are all happy to see the Women's club join after the successful introduction of the Men's Club and welcome them with open arms into the community.

A big off season has seen plenty of player movement which will make for an interesting competition across all grades for 2021. Let's hope Mother Nature gives us a break after what we've all been through and we can kick the season off with a bang.

Women's Grade 1/2

A tough introduction for GRWBC sees both teams on the road with GRWBC Green facing off against Weston Creek Women's BC. No doubt Weston Creek will be looking to build from a strong start to 2020, but Goulburn will have something to prove coming into the competition. Look out for the newcomers.

The GRWBC Gold squad starts the season on the road as well, heading to Canberra North BC to test themselves in some new water. Canberra North managed a mid-table finish at the abruptly interrupted 2020 season but will be looking to improve. Without any previous form, Goulburn could well prove to be a handful in 2021 and I'm sure all clubs will be looking at this match with interest to see where both clubs sit.

Canberra Bowling Club have combined with Yass Bowling Club to put together a strong team which rounds us out at 10 sides across the competition. They head to Yowani in round 1 to see if they can get the job done against some tough opposition who were in great form in the ACT Championships through late 2020 and early 2021.

Queanbeyan BC and QRSLMBC Blue will showdown in a local rivalry with both clubs looking to make a strong start to their campaign. Queanbeyan BC will get home ground advantage as QRSLMBC Blue cross the bridge to play on the beautiful new synthetic greens which were opened this week at QBC.

QRSLMBC Gold and Vikings finish off Round 1 with a matchup at QRSLMBC which will be an enticing affair for any onlookers as both clubs welcome new bowlers to the greens. With matches all starting at 9.30am it'll be tough to pick where to head to, but no doubt wherever you find yourself on Saturday morning you won't be disappointed.

2021 sees the Men's Grade 1 competition split into conferences to give us a full 10 round calendar. Each team will play the other three teams in their conference home and away, with a showdown across conferences for the middle four rounds ensuring that every teams plays each other once before the finals series.

On the North side we open up with Belconnen taking on Canberra North BC at home. Belconnen will be looking to put some early work in at home in the 2021 season with a big block of clubs finishing even through the 6 games played in 2020. Canberra North BC will need to be strong away from home but will look to put some early pressure on the ladder.

In our other North side matchup QRSLMBC will take on Yass. After a strong 2020 campaign QRSL have had some player movement which may effect the performances out on the greens. The pressure is on to put some early wins on the board to ensure they are well placed towards the back end of the season. Yass BC will be looking to improve on their performances in 2020 and try to bridge the gap to the rest of the field. This is an important match up for both clubs to get the season started well.

On the South side we get what could well turn out to be match of the round down at Forrest with Canberra BC taking on Queanbeyan BC. Both clubs have made strong moves off the green over the offseason and will be looking to put early wins in the bank. With Mac McLean joining QBC and Flynn O'Shaughnessy joining CBC both players will be looking to put in impressive performances in new colours as they establish themselves on the competition. Don't take your eyes away from this one.

Our other South side matchup brings us Weston Creek BC taking on Tuggeranong Vikings LBC in what will be a hotly contested affair. Tuggeranong have spent the offseason bolstering up their sides while Weston Creek were the strong performers in 2020. Weston Creek will look to show they've still got what it takes to be at the top while Vikings will look to show they've improved from 2020.
