Yowani CC Bowling Club v Queanbeyan RSLM Bowling Club – Gold @ Yowani

Queanbeyan have been struggling so far in 2021, a form line they are no doubt working hard to turn around as quickly as possible. Should be a win here for Goulburn, but never count anything out.

They sit second, but don't have a firm grip on the spot as the Creekers sit right behind them ready to pounce. Crucial mid-season matches all round, this is the time of year where you start to make or break the season.
