CONDITIONS OF PLAY

LADIES SIX PLAYER MEDLEY

- 1. Each side will play four games: (in the morning) two 18 end games of *three bowl triples*; plus (in the afternoon) one game of 21 end *three bowl pairs* and one standard *two bowl fours*.
- 2. Roll-up both ways in the morning and one way in the afternoon.
- 3. The morning games will be played to 18 ends or to the bell at 12.30 PM. The afternoon games will start about 1.30 PM and be played to 21 ends (Pairs), and 18 ends (Fours), or to the bell at 4.30 PM. The end in play shall be completed.
- 4. There will be no dead ends. The jack will be re-spotted on the tee.
- 5. 10 points will be awarded for a win or forfeit; 5 points for a draw; and zero for a loss.
- 6. One point will be awarded for each end won (half a point for a "tied" end).
- 7. To win, a side must have the highest "win" score at the end of the competition.
- 8. In the event of tied "win" scores, the winner will be determined by "ends" won. If the results are still equal, the winner will be determined by including "margins" for the affected sides.
- If a team is awarded a forfeit in any game, they will be awarded 10 "win" points plus "ends" and "margins" equal to the averages of the winning teams in that particular game.
- 10. Scorers are to cross-check cards with their opposite number before handing them in to the office and ensure the names of all team members (and not just team letters) are listed on the cards.
