CBC/BBC continue their good form through the back end of the year and in doing so make life tough for Vikings as they look like they'll fall short of a finals position. CBC/BBC have been pulling plenty of points through the last few rounds currently putting them up to 3rd on the table. Vikings face a tough ask to make the finals having to beat a strong Weston Creek outfit to make the finals now.

QRSL Gold continue on their merry way with another big win, this time against cross town rival Queanbeyan. They took a 29 shot win across the Molonglo and now steady themselves towards the finals. The loss means Queanbeyan are just the one point above Vikings, but they have the chance to seal the finals position with a win against Goulburn Gold this week which puts them in a good stead to make the finals.

Weston Creek and Norths played out an epic which in the end couldn't separate them on the overall board. Big wins for each club on the rinks were even in the end as they finished 40 a piece in the end. The draw gives Norths the chance to hold on to their Grade 1 position as we come into the final round, all be it a tough ask against the ladder leaders. Weston Creek seal their top four spot coming into the final round and will look to knock Vikings out of the competition.

Yowani put an important win on the board against Goulburn Green which gives them every chance of moving into the top four. The two clubs now sit just the two points apart on the table as it all comes down to the final round to settle the grades for the year. Both clubs will be out for a win to secure their position on the table coming into the finals.

Huge matchup here as Yowani sit just the one point ahead of QRSL Blue in a search for a double chance in Grade 2. Not only that, Grade 1 is still in reach for both clubs with some other matches going their way. Could be a massive swing pending the result of this match as we look at how we're going into the finals.

Goulburn Green will be looking to put the pressure on Norths this week as they go in hunt of a Grade 1 spot. CBC/BBC have had some good form over the past few weeks and are looking to finish the season in the same vein as the finals approach. This is another one that could shape the finals as the clubs below try to keep an eye on the result.



Queanbeyan Bowling Club v Goulburn Railway Women's Bowling Club – Gold @ QBC

Queanbeyan will look to hang onto their finals position and have the perfect chance to do so coming up against Goulburn Gold. Goulburn have had a tough year so far notching up just the one win for the year, but they have a chance here to make it two as QBC have struggled with consistency throughout the year. An interesting clash, but you'd be guessing QBC come away with a spot in the finals here.

Both matches on Saturday could have some impact on the shaping of the finals. QBC need the win to keep the dream alive and Goulburn will be looking to take the top spot for their own. If they can put 10 points on against Belconnen then they don't even need the extra match, top spot is theirs.

With that in mind if they get the job done then the fight for fourth is back on for Sunday as Belconnen play host to Vikings. Mathematically Vikings can get there, but you wouldn't count on it. They find themselves in the lucky position of playing both the clubs above them this weekend, but would need some massive results to go their way plus a win against Goulburn in the reschedule.

This leaves us with Belconnen and Queanbeyan fighting it out for fourth. Belconnen face a tough ask against Goulburn first up before they take on cellar dwellers Vikings. Queanbeyan will take on Vikings first before the head over to Weston Creek on Sunday to see if their hopes are still alive. The fight for fourth could well be between three clubs if Vikings can pull wins from both matches, but a strong performance from Belconnen across the weekend to pick up some of the rinks should be enough to get them across the line. They've got a 9 point lead on Queanbeyan and just need to pick up rinks.

Weston Creek will have to settle for third as the chase for a double chance was sniffed out by a loss to Belconnen. They sit comfortably in a finals position and a good performance against QBC would be enough to see them seal it. I'm making that sound worse than it is. Third or fourth place makes no difference as they head into the semi final looking for a win to push them through to take on some tough opposition.
