RE: 2021 Nationals

Bowls Australia has today announced that the 2021 Nationals will not be played in October of 2021. The decision has been made due to the continuing restrictions from COVID-19 and the uncertainty surrounding travel over the coming months.

As part of the decision the Australian Champion of Champions and the Australian Championships have been postponed to April 2022, while the other remaining events (Australian U-18 Championships, Australian Multi-Disability Championships, Australian Senior Sides Championships, and Australian Sides Championships) have been cancelled outright.

The postponed events will now run as follows at Broadbeach Bowls Club on the Gold Coast;

- Australian CoC: April 23 and 24, 2022
- Australian Championships: April 26-29, 2022

While the news may come as disappointing to some, Bowls ACT will endeavour to support those affected by the decision.

We would like to take the opportunity to remind Bowls ACT members to continue their efforts in supporting the community by adhering to all health directives in your local area. We will continue our efforts to bring bowls back as strong as ever on our return.
